PARTNERSHIP

The Wisconsin District of the Wesleyan Church has partnered with the Wesleyan Church of Uganda to help the church develop. They have agreed to help raise money for four different Global Partners' Projects. One of the projects was for the church to buy a vehicle. Two months ago they bought a Mitsubishi 4 wheel drive vehicle. This vehicle will help in evangelism, visiting churches and church development.

Leaders from the Wisconsin District have also come to teach at WBI, to help train the leaders of the Wesleyan Church of Uganda. They have given financial support to the church to buy seeds for local people to plant, and they came and converted a hand pump borehole to an electric well with a large water tank. That water system now supplies the water for the Wesley Primary School and the Busia Wesleyan Church.

A team from First Wesleyan Church in Bartlesville, Oklahoma came to teach at WBI, worked on rehabilitating a clinic and went out to hold rural clinics in churches.

A team from Penn - Jersey District came to build a church in Kamuli District.

Dr. Karl Westfall, a retired Pastor and District Superintendent, recently came and taught Missions and Minor Prophets to the students at WBI.

Two months ago we told you the story of how a team of 4 men and their sons came to Buwuni Wesleyan Church to help them build their new church.

These teams/individuals and others have partnered with the Church here in Uganda to help develop the church. Thank you for partnering together with the Church in Uganda in so many ways!

As Global Partner missionaries Carol and I have partnered together with you our prayer partners and the Wesleyan Church of Uganda to help train pastors, to help with adult literacy and in church development.

Partnership is important in the Kingdom of God. Everyone can be involved in that partnership. Some go, some give, and all pray. Then God brings in the harvest.

Carol and I are very thankful for your partnership with us here in Uganda. Many of you have also partnered with us in Swaziland (now called Eswatini) and in Zambia.

Philippians 1:4 says, "In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the Gospel from the first day until now, being confident of

this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."
