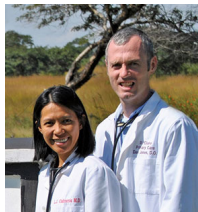

We attended the American Academy of Family Practice Global Health Workshop in Houston, TX from October 5-7. We met with Dr. Terry Bell on October 5. Terry is a pathologist with International Pathology Services (IPS). He has been providing pathology reports for our biopsy specimens from ZMH for the past 5 years.
